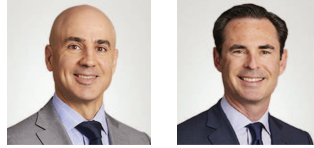

Securities mentioned that are not listed here or as a Top 10 Holding are no longer held in the portfolio as of the period end. Unless otherwise indicated, all information in this report includes all classes of shares, except performance and expense ratio information, and is as of the date shown in the upper right hand corner. Totals may not sum due to rounding.
